

FOCUS XII HALFWAY HOUSE...

A Rule 35 Facility

Focus XII Halfway House is a chemical dependency treatment program for men designed to provide a positive, structured living environment that serves as a transition from the highly structured treatment facility to independent community living.

Focus XII is housed in an eight-plex apartment building in which fifteen residents share five apartment units. The remaining units include an office/therapy center and a recreation center. Staff provide coverage 24 hours a day. The apartment plan encourages development of independence and self-reliance and is conveniently located on the bus line.

Residents grow through individual and group counseling sessions, having the responsibility of purchasing and preparing their own meals, and living in close quarters with others. The content of therapy is directed towards important aftercare issues such as relapse prevention skills, securing employment, and other behaviors needed to make a successful transition to independent living.

Men ages 18 or older who meet the criteria for Rule 25 and Consolidated Treatment Funding, who have completed a primary chemical dependency program, and have a strong desire to maintain sobriety are eligible for admission on a space available basis.

Focus XII is licensed under MN Department of Human Services Rule No. 31 and is a Supervised Living Facility by the Minnesota Department of Health.
